## DAY 1 - Join trip Naples Airport, drive to our hotel just outside Sorrento

Our trip starts at Naples airport from where it is around a 1.5 hour drive to the lovely Sorrento Peninsula, our base for the week exploring the glorious beauty and historic delights along this sought after region of southern Italy.

## DAY 2 - Train to Vesuvius, guided tour of Herculaneum

This morning sees us travelling by train to Vesuvius and walk to the rim of the volcanic crater, from where there are remarkable views of Naples, the coastal plain and the glistening bay. Vesuvius is the only active volcano on the European mainland and dominates the skyline between Naples and Pompeii, rising up from the flat and fertile plains. Since the mighty eruption of AD 79, which destroyed Pompeii and Herculaneum, it has had another 18 violent eruptions, the last one being in 1944, surprising the Allied forces and destroying an entire squadron of 88 B-25 bombers belonging to the American Air Force! Don't worry though - Vesuvius is amongst the most studied and closely monitored volcanoes in the world, so we should get plenty of warning if it does blow again.

From here we continue onto Herculaneum. Like Pompeii, Herculaneum was buried by the eruption. Unlike Pompeii, however,

Herculaneum was actually more preserved than destroyed by the blast; this means that many of the buildings within the site are still well preserved. On arrival we will enjoy a guided walk around this remarkably well-preserved example of a provincial Roman city, until one fateful day some 2,000 years ago when the powerful eruption of nearby Mount Vesuvius buried the city in hot ash, preserving forever the town and its unfortunate citizens.

Return to our hotel by train. Dinner is included tonight

## DAY 3 - Explore the clifftop towns of Positano and Amalfi

This morning we travel to the nearby towns of Positano and Amalfi. Driving one of the most famous coastal roads in the world, our visit to Amalfi is without doubt one of the highlights of this coastal region.

Stopping at Positano first, the town is perched on an enclave facing the Amalfi coast with sun bleached pastel coloured houses rising steeply from the water's edge interspersed with terraces full of lemon trees offering shade. Positano has more of an upmarket feel compared to its neighbour Amalfi, with a host of smart restaurants and highly fashionable retailers.

Continuing onto Amalfi, we have ample time to explore this compact town nestled between steep cliffs. The beautiful 11th Century Cathedral of St. Andrea dominates the town, with an impressive set of bronze doors that hailed from Constantinople, however it's well worth exploring the backstreets of Amalfi climbing up flights of steps to discover narrow alley ways of wisteria draped townhouses. Treat yourself to a gelato on the beach before heading back to our base in Sorrento.

## DAY 4 - Free day, optional day trip in Capri and visit the Blue Grotto

Today is a free day to explore Sorrento, head down to the beach or take an optional trip getting the hydrofoil across the Gulf of Naples to the beautiful island of Capri.

Capri is a glorious island; its seductive charms have attracted many visitors for thousands of years. There is an option to visit the delightful Villa San Michele. Built on the site of the ruins of the villa once owned by the emperor Tiberius, this elegant property contains an interesting museum and the gardens have fantastic views of the island, the Sorrento Peninsula and Mount Vesuvius. If sea conditions allow, there may be time to visit the celebrated Blue Grotto, where refracted sunlight through the translucent waters produces iridescent effects of light and colour. Alternatively, you can walk to the Villa Jovis, the ruins of Tiberius' cliff top palace from where the views over the island and the Bay of Naples are nothing short of spectacular (the climb takes about 45 minutes and is fairly strenuous). More fantastic views are afforded from the top of Mount Solare, which can be accessed by chairlift at Anacapri town. Please let your Explore leader know in advance if you wish to book this activity as the hydrofoil gets very busy in the holiday season.

# DAY 5 - Guided trip of Naples focusing on ghosts and legends. Evening pizza making

After breakfast head into Naples by train and explore Naples' must-see spots, including the Royal Palace, Naples Cathedral and the Posillipo quarter, where you'll soak up incredible views of the Bay of Naples. This morning's tour has a focus on legends and ghosts of this great city, including exploring the labyrinth of tunnels and caverns that spread below the old town. Either travel back with the group to Sorrento or spend an extra few hours to explore this wonderful city, taking a later train back to our hotel.

This evening you'll get a hands-on lesson in the thing most important to Italians, food! Enjoy a pizza cooking demonstration after which we get to sample our pizza creations.

# DAY 6 - Try Gelato Italiano ice cream in Sorrento. Free afternoon for optional kayaking or snorkelling along the Sorrento coast

Our morning walking tour takes us through the centre of Sorrento. Sorrento is a rich and elegant city which straddles the cliffs overlooking the water to Naples and Mount Vesuvius and boasts plenty of good quality restaurants and cafe bars from where you can do what the Italians do best - people watching. The city is originally a favoured summer retreat of the Romans and attracted the likes of Casanova, Byron and Wagner so as you can see, we are in good company. On this tour, we see and experience some of the highlights of Sorrento such as the Cathedral, the public gardens and most importantly, a classic of Italian culture - the Gelato Italiano (Italian ice cream).

This afternoon left free to try kayaking or snorkelling along the Sorrento coast, exploring the inlets, coves and crystal clear waters of the Amalfi coast. Alternatively stroll down to the beach from our hotel

A selection of optional activities are listed below to help you budget for your Family adventure. Whilst the basic tour price you pay before you travel includes a great selection of highlights, we have also built in free time on this Explore 'lite' family holiday to allow you the flexibility to choose from a carefully selected range of additional excursions and activities or take time to relax, the choice is yours. At certain destinations along the way there may be several options to choose from and it may not be possible to fit all the activities in; your Explore Leader will be able to give advice on which are the most suitable for your family.

Almafi:

Day 3: Paper mill museum €3.50 per person

Day 3: Access to Villa Cimbrone, €7 adult €5 children under 10. Access to Villa Rufolo in Ravello €7 adult €5 children under 12

Capri:

Day 4: Full day trip to Capri by hydrofoil including a boat trip around the island €52 per person.

Day 4: For panoramic views of Capri get the chairlift from Piazza Vittoria in Anacapri to Monte Solaro, 589 meters above sea level €11 per person.

Day 4: Entrance to Villa San Michele with spectacular sea views and fine gardens €8 per person.

Days 6 or 7: Mozzarella factory. €32 per person

A one hour introduction to the art of mozzarella making. The tour includes the opportunity to create your own mozzarella with the help of professional cheese makers and time in the tasting room to sample all kinds of cheese from fresh mozzarella to the smoked variety accompanied of course with a glass of local wine.

Days 6 or 7: Kayaking in Sorrento. 2 hours €35 per person, 3 hours €45 per person

Single or double kayaks available - full guided tour to explore many of the archaeological sites of the Sorrento peninsula including ancient Roman villas and secluded bays.

Days 6 or 7: Snorkelling in Sorrento. 3 hour boat excursion €35 per person, departs at 0930 and 1500

Naples:

Days 4,6 or 7: Naples hop on hop off bus, €23 adult, €11.50 children under 15, €66 family ticket (2 adults and 3 children) It's possible to purchase a card that gives access to dozens of museums and cultural sites, the artecard Napoli costs €21 adults, €12 child and lasts for 3 days.

# Clothing

### **Booking a Single Room**

All of our group tours are planned and operated on a twin-share basis, meaning that the standard cost is based either on individual

travellers sharing accommodation with another group member of the same sex, or people who book together sharing accommodation. Please refer to the tour notes where the single room option availability is detailed on a night by night basis for this tour, and the price for the available nights is detailed on the dates & prices tab by departure date. For Self-Guided trips the Single Room supplement offers the option of a single room each and is charged per person. The Single Room supplement also applies to the third person in a party of three that will be accommodated in a single room.

Our hotel in Sorrento offers a very comfortable stay with a large pool and terrace area from where we can relax in the greenery of a small citrus grove. There is also a gym with a cardio-fitness system as well as a spa wellness area where you can have massages and beauty treatments. The restaurant serves dishes based upon the Sorrento and Neapolitan culinary traditions. Each room is equipped with satellite TV, Wi-Fi, air-conditioning, minibar and hairdryer. The hotel in Scala is a newly built family run hotel in the centre of the town with a large terrace for sunbathing, a swimming pool and solarium. Ensuite rooms have a balcony, TV and air-conditioning. There is also a bar and restaurant with a terrace that overlooks the surrounding area.

### Joining Tour Abroad

Customers booked on the 'Land Only' arrangements will now receive a Free Transfer, provided you arrive and depart on the tour only itinerary start and end dates. The transfers will be from the Explore designated airport or train station to the joining point of your tour, and then back from the ending point to the designated airport or train station. The exception to this rule is customers

who are booked on a tour where the joining and ending point is at the designated airport or train station. Free transfers are not available for Self-Guided, Polar, Tailormade or Tours for Churches customers. If you are not eligible for the Free Transfer then you will need to make your own way through to the joining and ending point.
