DAY 3 - Moremi Game Reserve

Following an early breakfast you will meet your guide and set off to the Okavango Delta. Moremi Game Reserve is home to a wide variety of animals and birds including lions, buffaloes, elephants, leopard, storks, wattled cranes and many species of kingfishers and bee-eaters, you're likely to spot many animals en route to your campsite too.

DAY 4 - Moremi Game Reserve

Moremi covers much of the eastern side of the Okavango Delta and combines permanent water with drier areas, creating unexpected contrasts and a unique environment. The wildlife varies between large herds of elephants and buffaloes to cheetahs, hyenas, wild dogs, giraffes, leopards, lions and jackals, plus a full range of antelope including the rarer red lechwe. The birdlife is

vast and varied, and ranges from elegant water birds to a huge variety of ducks, geese and heron. Today you enjoy early morning and afternoon game drives in the park, heading back to camp for lunch and some time to relax.

DAY 5 - Final day in Moremi Game Reserve

Your last day to explore Moremi Game Reserve will be spent on morning and afternoon game drives within this vast and varied reserve.

DAY 6 - Journey to Savuti

Today you head to Chobe National Park, where you will spend tonight in a wilderness campsite in the Savuti region, exploring the desert-like landscape on game drives. Never has there been a better time to visit Savuti, as the waters from the Savuti Channel reach the marsh for the first time in 30 years. During game drives your guides will take you to the marsh, the Savuti Channel and the hills. Savuti has a very healthy population of leopard who live on the hills and the best time to see them is either first or last light and they leave their stony refuge to hunt. You may also spot large herds of impala, wildebeest, giraffe, tsessebe, buffalo or elephant.

DAY 7 - Continue to Chobe Riverfront

Today you journey north, deeper into the national park and set up camp along the Chobe River, exploring the riverbanks and surrounding flood plains on game drives along the way. Look out for African fish eagles swooping for their prey and large herds of elephant cooling off at the riverbank.

DAY 8 - Game drives along the Chobe River

Today you have morning and afternoon game drives in the national park. Following the Chobe River as it meanders through the national park you'll hopefully see pods of hippo, crocodile and elephants in and around the riverbanks. The Chobe River is also home to a wonderful variety of birdlife and offers spectacular photographic opportunities as the sun sets across the water.

Booking a Single Room

All of our group tours are planned and operated on a twin-share basis, meaning that the standard cost is based either on individual travellers sharing accommodation with another group member of the same sex, or people who book together sharing accommodation. Please refer to the tour notes where the single room option availability is detailed on a night by night basis for this tour, and the price for the available nights is detailed on the dates & prices tab by departure date. For Self-Guided trips the Single Room supplement offers the option of a single room each and is charged per person. The Single Room supplement also applies to the third person in a party of three that will be accommodated in a single room.

Standard

Light on your pocket but long on authentic experiences, these tours are based in simple, sometimes local-style accommodation. If your idea of adventure travel is to experience real, everyday life then you will enjoy our Simple style of tour. You will have the chance to stay at simple, family-run hotels and guesthouses where the lack of luxury is more than compensated for by the warm welcome and genuine insight into local life.

Thamalakane River Lodge

Thamalakane River Lodge, on the banks of the Thamalakane River is in a quiet location, 19 km outside of Maun. The spacious, en

suite stone chalets overlook the river. There is an outdoor swimming pool and a la carte restaurant.

Mobile camping - Semi-participatory

Your mobile camping safari is semi-participatory which means you are expected to assist with setting-up and taking down the camp. The camp chef will be on-hand to prepare and cook all meals. You will camp in private, designated campsites with shared facilities, in two-man dome tents, however you will need to bring your own sleeping bag.

Maramba River Lodge

Maramba River Lodge offers comfortable en suite safari tents. Nestled within mopane and mahogany trees with views overlooking Maramba River or the waterhole, the camp is a good base from which to explore Livingstone. The lodge has a swimming pool and outdoor dining area where guests can enjoy the views over the river.

Premium

On premium level tailor-made tours you will stay at comfortable mid-range hotels, chosen for their location, ambiance or local character. Your rooms will be clean and well-appointed, with en suite bathrooms and air-conditioning or heating as necessary. Standard level hotels normally have restaurants, bars and often other amenities such as a swimming pool and gardens, offering a good level of comfort at a reasonable price.

Thamalakane River Lodge

Thamalakane River Lodge, on the banks of the Thamalakane River is in a quiet location, 19 km outside of Maun. The spacious, en suite stone chalets overlook the river. There is an outdoor swimming pool and a la carte restaurant.

Mobile camping - Non-participatory

This mobile camping safari is non-participatory and fully staffed to ensure your adventure goes smoothly. Your camp will be set up for you on arrival with three metre walk-in dome tents, en suite toilet and bush shower tent. Hearty home made meals will be prepared for you with a selection of drinks included.

Avani Victoria Falls Hotel

A uniquely designed property with the look and feel of an old walled city. Each room has a private balcony and the restaurant and bar surround a cool, landscaped pool area.

Booking a land only package with Explore

Customers who have chosen to book on the 'Land Only' arrangements of our tour, please ensure that you have checked your tour specific 'Joining Instructions' prior to booking your own travel arrangements. Your joining instructions can be found below in the dates and prices information.

You may also be eligible for the Free Explore Transfer.

Joining Tour Abroad

Customers booked on the 'Land Only' arrangements will now receive a Free Transfer, provided you arrive and depart on the tour only itinerary start and end dates. The transfers will be from the Explore designated airport or train station to the joining point of your tour, and then back from the ending point to the designated airport or train station. The exception to this rule is customers

who are booked on a tour where the joining and ending point is at the designated airport or train station.

Free transfers are not available for Self-Guided, Polar, Tailormade or Tours for Churches customers.

If you are not eligible for the Free Transfer then you will need to make your own way through to the joining and ending point. On a majority of our tours Explore will be able to provide a private transfer at an additional cost. Please ask for a quote at the time of booking.

Insurance

It is a condition of booking with Explore that you have adequate valid travel insurance. It is your responsibility to arrange appropriate travel insurance and ensure you have read and understood the full terms and conditions of your travel insurance policy to ensure that you are covered for all activities you intend to undertake whilst on the tour, including all optional activities. Your Insurance Policy must fully cover you for medical expenses and emergency repatriation to your home country. Please ensure your policy includes medical emergency helicopter evacuation in the event of illness or injury and covers the entire duration of your holiday. If you are trekking at altitude please ensure that there is no upper altitude limit which may limit or exclude cover for your trip. The cost of many of our Polar Voyages will exceed the capped amount covered by standard insurance premiums and you will be required to pay an additional premium to cover the full value of your trip. Please ensure that you are covered for the full amount of your holiday cost, as insufficient cover could invalidate a claim under the policy. Medical and repatriation insurance cover is not mandatory for UK residents who are travelling on trips within the United Kingdom.

We have a good selection of flights not only from London but from many regional airports around the UK allowing us to compare fares between scheduled carriers as well as low cost and charter airlines. Vaccinations

We do recommend protection against malaria, hepatitis A, tetanus, typhoid and polio. Consult your travel clinic for latest advice on different prophylaxis available against malaria. Travellers may wish to immunize themselves against meningitis. Please check the latest requirements with your travel clinic or doctor prior to departure. The above is not an exhaustive list. Visa and vaccination requirements are subject to change and should be confirmed by you before travelling. Immigration/Borders in Botswana are requesting a Yellow Fever certificate if you have previously travelled within/via an endemic country.
